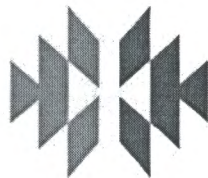

Memorandum of understanding on mutual cooperation

The Unitary Enterprise on rendering services "Gomel Branch of the Belarusian Chamber of Commerce and Industry" of the non-governmental non-profit organization "Belarusian Chamber of Commerce and Industry", represented by the General Director Marina Filonova, acting on the basis of the Charter on the one hand, and Contracting Chamber of Economy Pirot District, represented by the President Dragan Kostic PhD, acting on the basis of the Charter on the other hand, supporting the idea of expanding trade and economic ties between Serbia and the Republic of Belarus, guided by the goal of assisting enterprises, organizations and firms in developing business ties and expanding mutually beneficial cooperation, have concluded the present Memorandum of understanding on mutual cooperation.

Article 1

The Parties undertake obligations to support and strengthen the expansion of contacts through the economy and trade, to promote the deepening of all forms of foreign economic activity, including the establishment of joint ventures.

Article 2

The Parties will render all possible assistance in establishing cooperation between small and medium-sized enterprises of Serbia and the Republic of Belarus.

Article 3

The Parties shall promote the organization of business contacts between Serbian and Belarusian entrepreneurs, joint training of specialists, holding seminars, conferences and other congress and exhibition events to familiarize business circles with the economies and export opportunities of both countries

Article 4

The Parties undertake obligations to exchange information and publications on the economy, foreign trade, trade and customs legislation and other information that may be in demand for partners of both Parties.

Article 5

The Parties undertake obligations to pay special attention to mutual cooperation in the field of arbitration, mediation, as well as in trade and market relations, in the field of quality control and inspection of imports and exports of goods.

Article 6

The Parties undertake obligations to monitor the correct implementation of the provisions of the Protocol of intentions. To this end, and for the coordination of further activities, representatives of the Parties may meet as necessary, having agreed upon the date of the visit.

Article 7

This Memorandum of understanding on mutual cooperation shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties. Each Party may terminate this Memorandum of understanding on mutual cooperation by written notice. The termination of this Memorandum of understanding on mutual cooperation comes 30 days after the receipt of the said notice by the other Party. Changes and additions to this Memorandum of understanding on mutual cooperation may be made by mutual written agreement of the Parties.
